

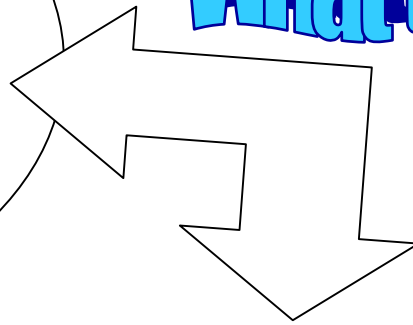
# END OF LIFE CARE

  - b. psychosocial
  - c. emotional
  - d. spiritual needs
